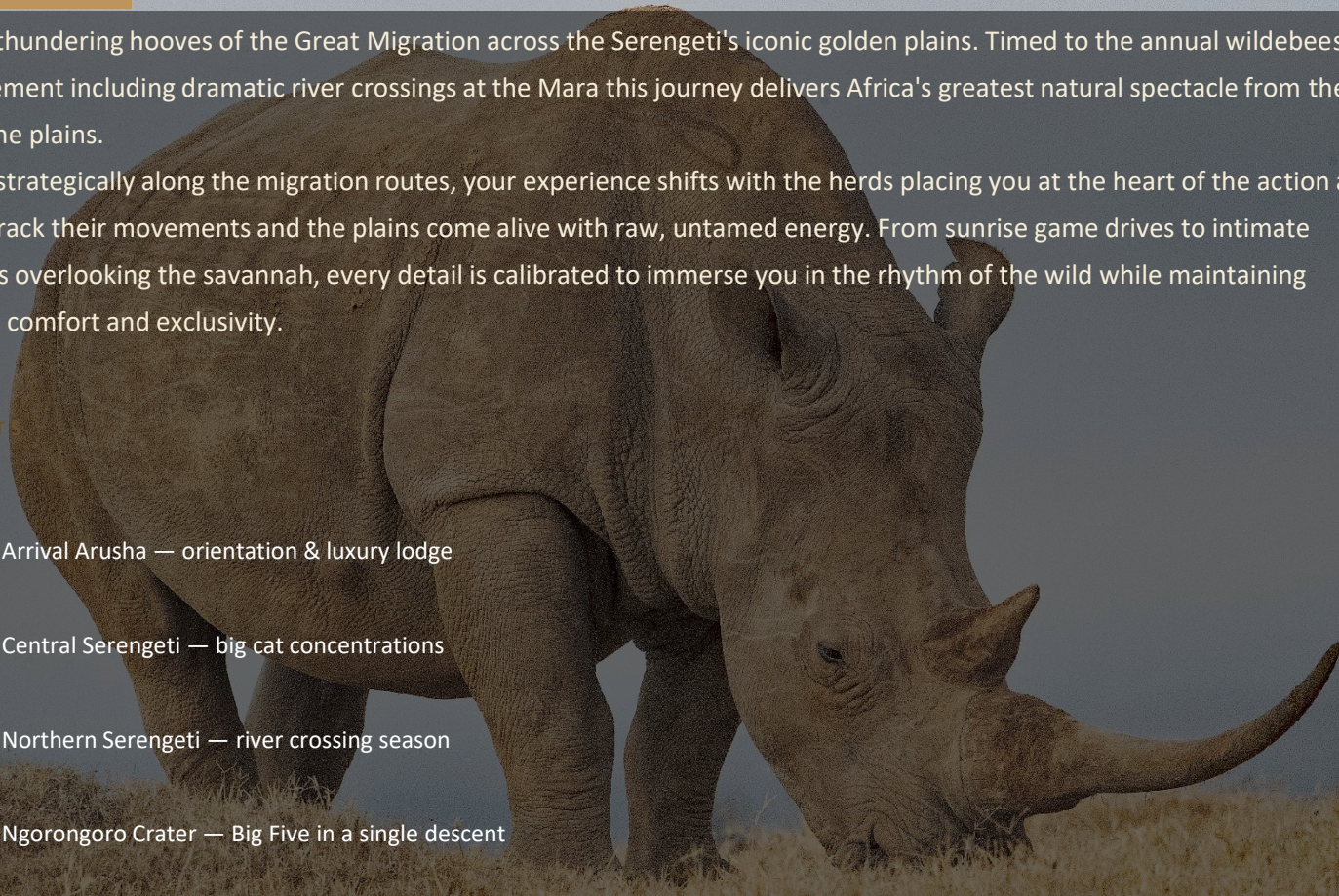

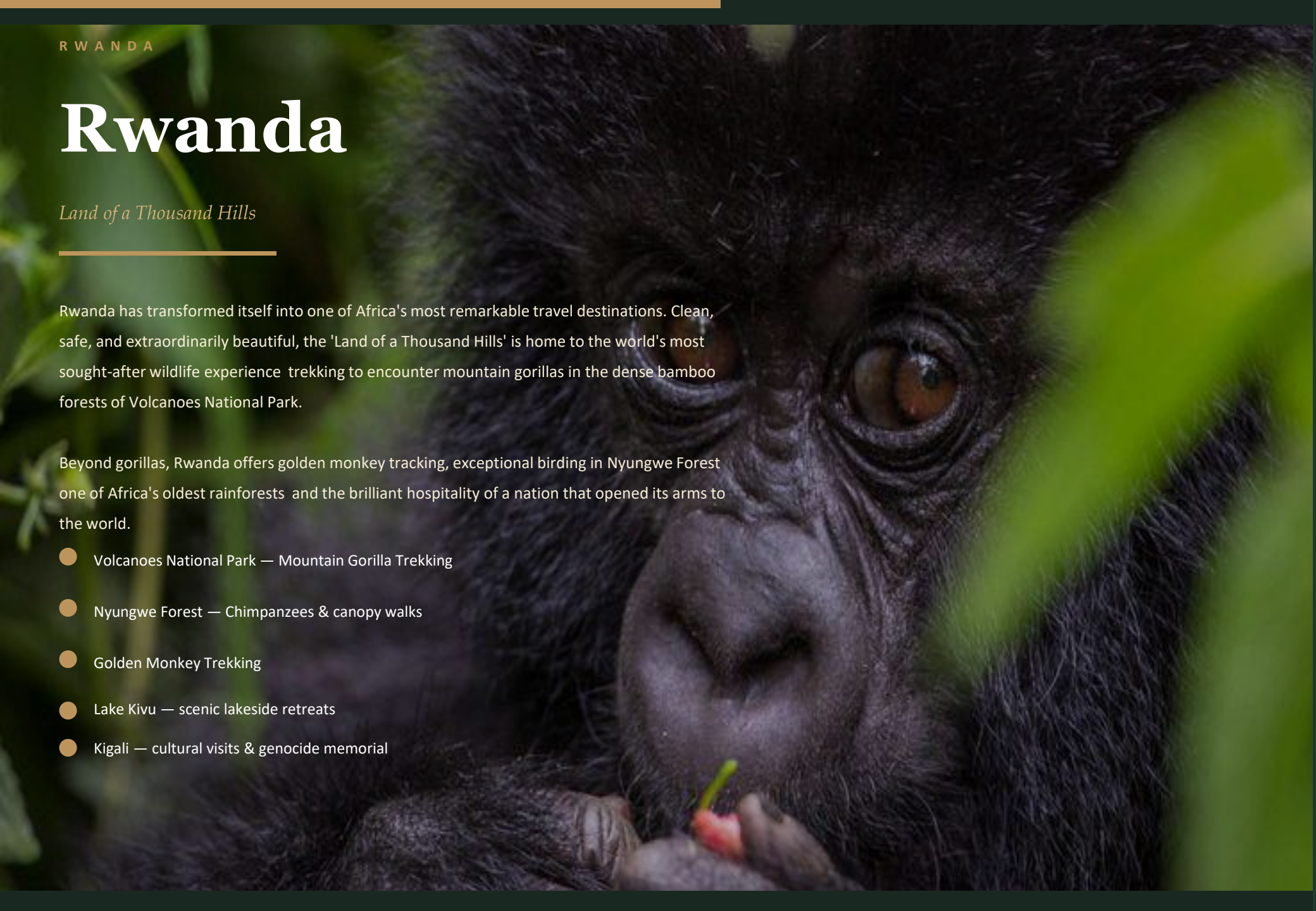

This vast, sparsely populated country larger than Texas but home to fewer than three million people harbours landscapes of extraordinary alien beauty: the ancient orange dunes of Sossusvlei, the wildlife-rich Etosha Pan, the ghost town of Kolmanskop swallowed by desert sand, and the Skeleton Coast where the cold Atlantic meets the Namib Desert.

For photographers, adventurers, and seekers of absolute solitude, Namibia is Africa's ultimate road less travelled.

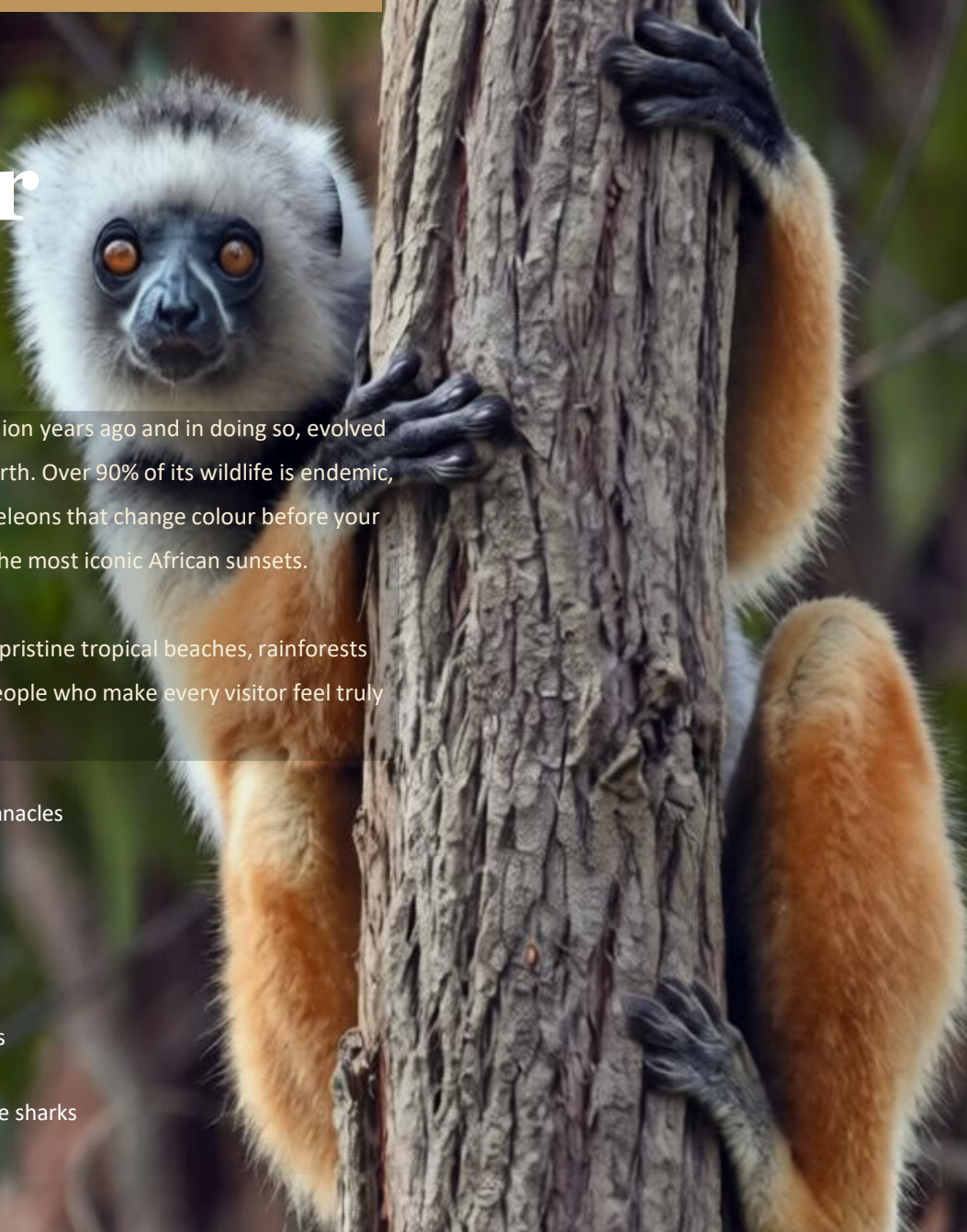
Madagascar

The Eighth Continent

Madagascar broke free from the African continent 88 million years ago and in doing so, evolved an astonishing array of species found nowhere else on Earth. Over 90% of its wildlife is endemic, including all of its lemur species (over 100), bizarre chameleons that change colour before your eyes, and ancient baobab trees whose silhouettes paint the most iconic African sunsets.

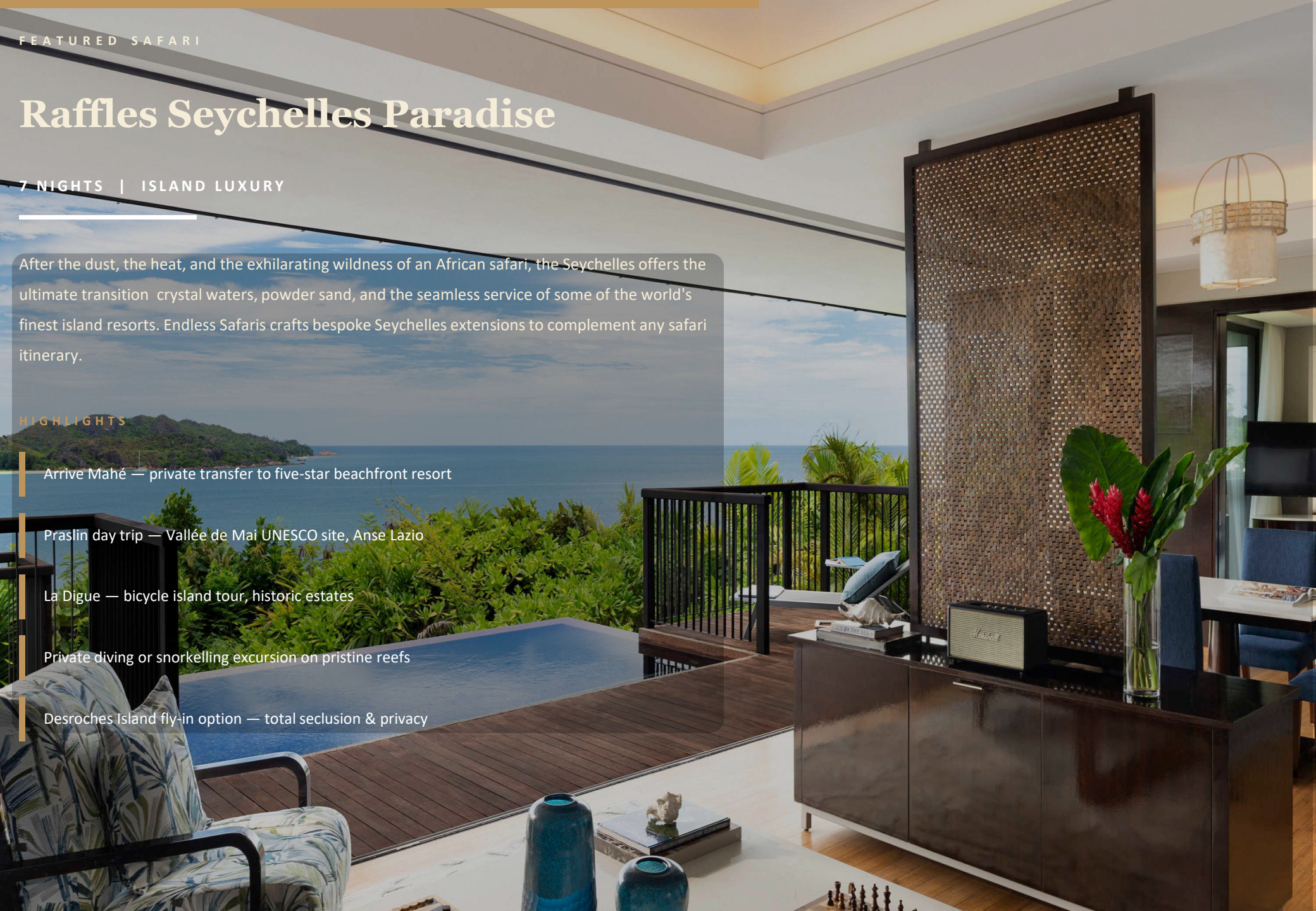

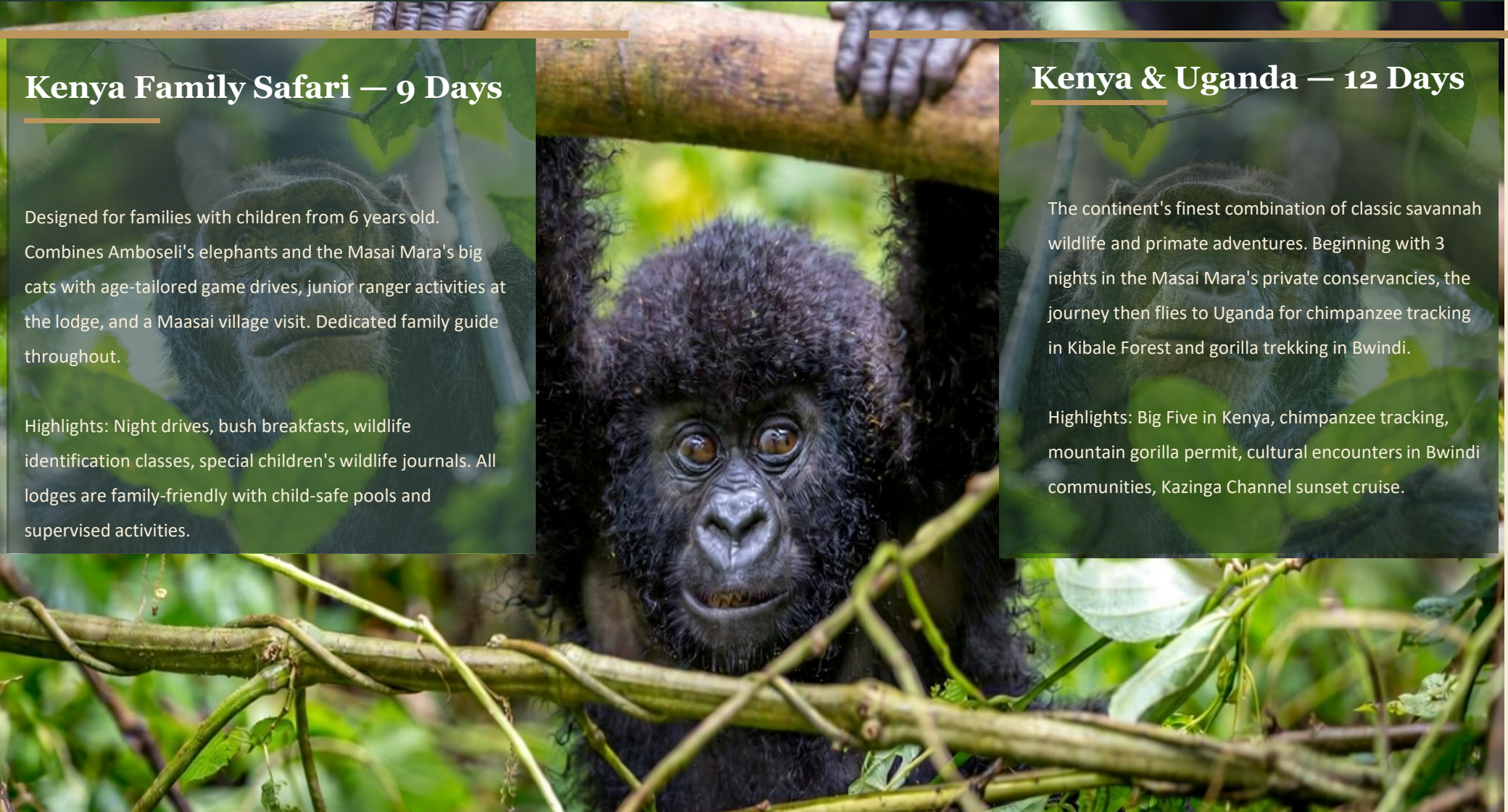
